

## **Jesus-The Great High Priest**

### **Part 7-The Great Hope**

#### **Hebrews 6:12-20**

#### **Consider the example of Abraham...**

*Then you will not become spiritually dull and indifferent. Instead, you will follow the example of those who are going to inherit God's promises because of their faith and endurance.*

*For example, there was God's promise to Abraham. Since there was no one greater to swear by, God took an oath in His own name, saying:*

*"I will certainly bless you,  
and I will multiply your descendants beyond number."*

*Then Abraham waited patiently, and he received what God had promised. Hebrews 6:12-15 NLT*

#### **Three Things We Can Trust...**

##### **1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of God.**

*Now when people take an oath, they call on someone greater than themselves to hold them to it. And without any question that oath is binding. <sup>17</sup> God also bound Himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that he would never change His mind. Hebrews 6:16-17 NLT*

##### **2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of God.**

*So God has given both His promise and His oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. Hebrews 6:18 NLT*

##### **3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of God.**

*This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary. Jesus has already gone in there for us. He has become our eternal High Priest in the order of Melchizedek. Hebrews 6:18-19 NLT*

#### **As we hold on through the struggles of life...**

##### **1. We can place our \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus.**

*I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.  
Romans 15:13 NLT*

**2. We can find our \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus.**

*This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary. Hebrews 6:19 NLT*

**3. We can learn to \_\_\_\_\_ on the promises of God to be fulfilled.**

*We put our hope in the LORD.*

*He is our help and our shield.*

*In Him our hearts rejoice,*

*for we trust in His holy name.*

*Let your unfailing love surround us, LORD,*

*for our hope is in You alone. Psalm 33:20-22 NLT*
